

# **SIT-Com In-Kind Contributor Status**

Roughly 30 groups (US/Chile + International) comprising ~100 individuals are making in-kind contributions to SIT-Com.

We are currently in the process of onboarding, creating accounts, and defining concrete initial work assignments



## **Onboarding Status**

On 2 June 2022, Rubin Observatory sent an email with information about the onboarding process and next steps for in-kind groups that are contributing to Rubin Observatory Systems Integration and Commissioning (SIT-Com) efforts. We contacted groups participating in the

- US/Chile Commissioning Announcement of Opportunity Program and
- International In-Kind Contribution Program where the recipient group is the "Rubin Commissioning Team".

The email was sent to the designated point of contact for each in-kind contributing group meeting the criteria above with instructions to forward the information to the other participants in the group. (see <u>LSST Community post</u>)

### **Onboarding Status**

- Two action items for in-kind groups (given in June 2022)
  - Individuals enter information on <u>user spreadsheet</u> so Rubin Obs can create accounts
  - Groups connect with their designated <u>Rubin contacts</u> to help refine work assignments
- LDAP accounts
  - Slack
  - Confluence
  - o Jira
- Computing accounts at US Data Facility (USDF) at SLAC National Lab
  - General commissioning data analysis work will use the USDF
  - Initial round of invites sent Tuesday 5 July; now setting up accounts
  - Currently in the process of standing up capabilities at the USDF (see presentation from Richard Dubois at recent <u>DM Science Pipelines Bootcamp</u>)

## **Onboarding Status**

Accounts:

- About half of the in-kind contributors have responded to invitation to set up computing accounts at USDF
- LDAP accounts seem not to have been created yet ... need to check on this again

Many of the in-kind contributing groups have held initial meetings with their designated Rubin Contact to start planning concrete work assignments.

We have been working closely with a few groups to help get started:

- 5 contributions from LSST:France will be managed similarly to the US/Chile groups
- Photometric calibration contribution Elana Urbach is new point of contact
